Progression focus: Supported employment, with a view to reduction in support depending on reasonable adjustments, and with the ultimate goal of paid employment.

Programme content: Divided in 2 main parts, theory (employment skills) and real setting work experience in 2 different organisations based in 4 sites in total, including:

Part 1: Theory

Queensmill Employability Curriculum

This comprehensive curriculum covers key areas essential for workplace readiness, including:

- Team Building; Health & Safety; ICT Skills; Self-Advocacy; Employment Skills; Financial Literacy; Health & Wellness; Preparing for Employment; Customer Service & Effective Communication Skills

ASDAN Employability Award

- **Accreditation: ASDAN Award in Employability skills (E2-L2).**



This qualification, with a total of 60 hours of guided learning, is designed to equip learners with the skills necessary to succeed in the workplace. Its main goal is to help learners overcome barriers to employment and develop confidence as they transition into the workforce.

Inclusive Working - CPD Certification



Learners will receive 8 CPD certificates, covering critical areas such as:

- Fire Safety; Health & Safety; Infection Prevention; Data Protection; Moving & Handling; Personal Safety Awareness; Introduction to Employability; Introduction to Hospitality

The programme includes a blend of:

- Classroom activities (suitable for Entry Level and Level 1+)
- eLearning modules
- A comprehensive handbook with interactive activities

All materials are tailored to meet the needs of young people with learning disabilities and/or neurodivergent conditions.

Careers Programme

Each intern will benefit from a structured careers programme, with guidance and insights provided by experienced employers. This ensures real-world advice and hands-on experience to support their journey into the workplace.



Part 2: Work Experience

We offer supported working experience throughout the academic year.

Interns will complete 3 different rotations in 3 different departments across any of the sites, supported by a job coach, a job developer and a mentor. Reasonable adjustments will be considered by departments in order to increase interns' performance and become more accessible.
